At this month's council meeting there were new planning applications:

No. 5855. Erection of an agricultural building to house livestock on the land to the east of Low Wood & Borwick Fold, Crook.

No. 5846. Rose Mount, Brow Lane, Staveley partial cedar cladding to the south gable and east fascia.

No.5664. Fairbank Farm, Staveley, Change of use of Agricultural Barns to Wedding Venue was approved with conditions.
