STAVELEY WITH INGS PARISH COUNCIL - LATEST NEWS

The Staveley with Ings Parish Council meeting was held in Ings Village Hall on July 2nd 2025. All residents are invited to the Parish Council meetings and are given the chance in the public participation section to give their views and question the Parish Council on issues on the agenda or raise issues for future discussion. During this part of the meeting, discussions were had regarding the parking of a vehicle advertising a local caravan park that was parked in an area that was deemed unsafe and distraction to local traffic. The Clerk was asked to report the concerns to the relative authorities. For a full copy of the minutes please see the website above. There were a number of new planning applications and determined applications. Please see the Parish Council website for more details. The next meeting is on Monday 1st September at 7.15pm at the Ayland Pavilion.

The Consultation update on the 20mph proposal in parts of Ings has shown that the residents of Ings have responded in favour of the speed reduction and as a percentage of residents, we have responded in greater numbers than any other parishes that have made a similar request. The final decision has not yet been made yet but as we are top of the list it is looking positive.

After county council closed the Abbey Care Home in 2019 a decision has recently been taken to convert the site into affordable homes. A developer has been chosen however the proposal has yet to be finalized, more details to follow when we have them.

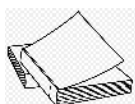
